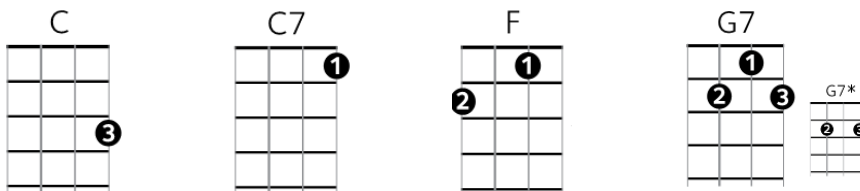

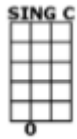

CHORD SHAPES FOR C, C7, F & G7*



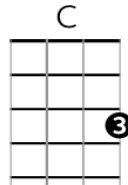

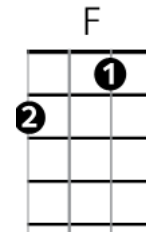




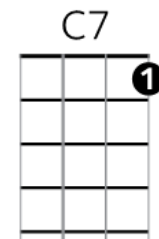
Singing In The Rain

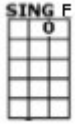

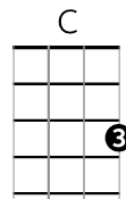




Buffalo Gals

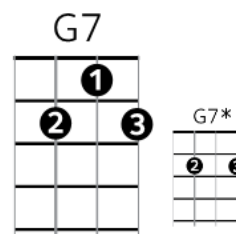
